1. Public Wine Tasting and Cellar Tour

Our Downstairs Cellar is open to the public between 09h00 and 17h00, Monday to Sunday. The public cellar tour takes place twice daily, at 10h30 and 14h30.

2. Wine Tasting and Cellar Tour for Groups (larger than 10 pax, up to a max of 40)

Visits of tour groups and private tours have to be arranged in advance. Tastings are held either in the 'Downstairs' tasting cellar or the Vat Cellar, depending on group size, availability and weather. The formal tasting includes the tasting of six wines. A tour of our production cellar is included. Please allow one and a half hours for the tour and tasting.

Tour guides are served the same as the group, free of charge, and the driver qualifies for a 20% discount.

NB: unannounced, late arrivals may result in the cancellation of the cellar tour.
